And it is potentially available to the student who best fills out this application. You must be currently enrolled in an institution or have confirmation of enrollment in Washington, Oregon, or Idaho. Yearly Application. **Application must be postmarked or electronically received by midnight: JUNE 1, 20XX.** Note: There will be no exceptions. Any applications received after JUNE 1 will be disqualified. Applicants must follow application instructions to the letter or will be disqualified without notice. This form may be photocopied. Scholarship reviews will begin JUNE 2. Award recipients will be notified electronically in July. Awards will be mailed out by August 15. Do not contact CLAW for application status. If you have a problem filling in the form electronically, print it out. No application or associated documentation will be returned to applicants. Recipient names will be listed on the CLAW website.
